BACKGROUND - Trynmuir, Cupar Muir

Our new development at Cupar Muir, Fife provided 25 new homes for Social Rent. It offered a range of properties including a wheelchair cottage, amenity flats along with 2,3 & 4 bed houses

Set in a semi-rural location Cupar Muir is a small village in North East Fife situated on the outskirts of Cupar. Offering good transport and footpath links into the town, residents have access to a range of amenities including shops, a leisure centre, play parks, restaurants and a train station which provides routes to Dundee, Aberdeen and Edinburgh.

The new homes provided residents with an energy efficient home which included 'A' rated, dual zone combi boilers with a flue gas heat recovery system and Photovoltaic Panels. The properties also met Housing for Varying Needs, Secured by Design and the Associations own design standards.


