BACKGROUND – Burnbrae, Kincardine

This site is located near the town centre of Kincardine. It is a sloping site, accessed off Osborne Drive and just a few minutes walk from the town centre and Kincardine Bridge.

The project has required significant retention to enable development and has had to overcome issues through the planning process and limitations on sewer capacity.

The completed development will provide 29 houses, flats and an amenity bungalow for social rent and 7 houses for mid market rent which will be managed by Kingdom Initiatives. Floor coverings, window blinds and an electric hob and oven will be provided for the mid market rent units.

The specification of the units fully complies with the requirements of the Section 7 Silver Level of the 2011 Building Regulation.

The estimated completion date for all properties is November 2018.




