BACKGROUND - Kingseat Road, Kingseat

This development was part of the affordable element of the larger private Taylor Wimpey site off Kingseat Road.

The village of Kingseat is situated approximately 3 miles north east of Dunfermline. It has a resident population of around 800 and has good communication links with the rest of Fife, being close to the M90.

This development provided 14 new homes for Social Rent comprising of a mix of Cottage Flats, Semi Detached and Mid Terraced Houses. The development achieved 'Gold' Secured by Design accreditation.

The new homes are highly efficient and achieved an energy rating of B (81-91)

Community Benefits were delivered under the contract in line with the Client Based Approach Matrix.

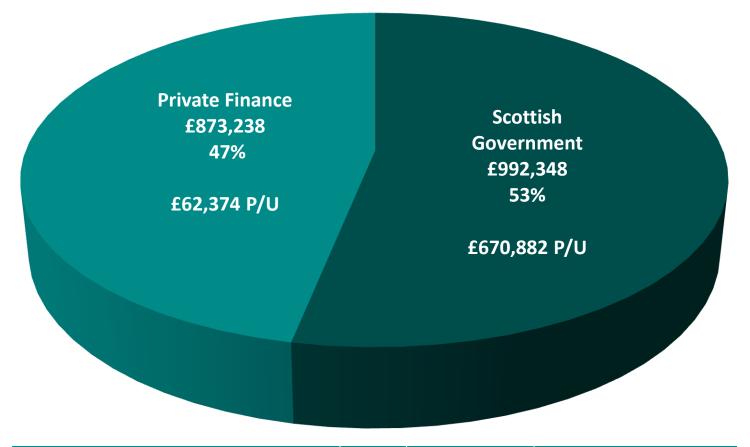
