# BACKGROUND - Hugh Place, Lochgelly

This development provided 27 new homes for social rent on the site of a former Fife Council transport depot.

All existing buildings were removed by 2006 with the site being undeveloped since. There was an established Fagus Sylvatica Purpurea (Copper Beech) tree present on the site which was subject to a Tree Preservation Order, this was incorporated into the landscaping plans for the development.

All of the properties achieved Building Controls Full Bronze and Silver Aspects 1 & 2 Standard of sustainability through the installation of Photo Voltaic Panels, DMEV (Decentralised Mechanical Extract Ventilation) Systems and increased levels of insulation.

Ownership of the new homes transferred to Ore Valley Housing Association on completion as part of the Fife Housing Association Alliance model.


