

## Tenancy Sustainment

# Energy Advice

We can help you get registered with your supplier and work with you to make sure that you don't pay too much for your gas and electricity. We can also help you apply for grants such as the Warm Home Discount Scheme and advise you on your eligibility for cold weather payments.

Lots of people find it difficult to pay their energy bills. If you get into arrears with your utilities we will help you arrange the lowest possible repayments and can help you apply to have energy debts written off.

Whether you have a prepayment meter or pay for energy use in a different way, if you are struggling with your energy costs, we can help.
